READ AND DISCUSS PROVERBS 3:5-6, 16:3, 16:9

Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take (Proverbs 3:5-6 NLT).

Commit your actions to the Lord, and your plans will succeed (Proverbs 16:3 NLT).

We can make our plans, but the Lord determines our steps (Proverbs 16:9 NLT).

- In order to trust someone with all your heart, what kind of faith must you have in them? How can you have that kind of faith in God?
- What do you think it means that He will make your path straight? Can you make your own path straight? Explain.
- What actions are required in committing all of your ways to God? List some practical ways we can commit to this.
- Is trusting God with all of your heart a one-time action?
